At a regular meeting of the Upshur County Commissioners Court held at the Courthouse, Gilmer, Texas, at which a quorum was present, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Upshur County's most recent population estimate from the United States Census Bureau is projected to be over 40,295; and

WHEREAS, Census statistics project that 16.7% of Upshur County's estimated population is age 65 or over; and

WHEREAS, Census statistics further project that of the Upshur County population who are age 65 or over, 11.4% of that number fall below the poverty level; and


WHEREAS, Upshur County Commissioners Court is concerned about its citizens living in unsafe and unhealthy conditions; and

WHEREAS, Longview Habitat for Humanity strives to create community stability through critical home repair for low to moderate income families; and


