WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court understands and agrees with the Findings and Recommendations of the Master Plan for Restoration of the Upshur County Courthouse, and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court recognizes that a percentage of the Courthouse Restoration Project will require funding by the County.






